

**Federal Emergency Grant Assistance**

In 1996, NARFE entered into a partnership with FEEA (Federal Employee Education and Assistance Program) to provide emergency disaster assistance to NARFE members who are victims of a declared natural disaster through the NARFE-FEEA Disaster Fund. NARFE became a member of FEEA's board of directors in 1997.

The fund is supported by tax deductible donations from NARFE members and friends of NARFE and is administered by FEEA.

NARFE members have donated some \$458,000 in aid to NARFE members who were affected by Hurricane Katrina, Superstorm Sandy and other natural disasters.

NARFE disaster funds in the form of cash grants (\$500 maximum per grant per household) are available to all NARFE members in good standing who have been injured, incurred property damage or have other needs during and after a declared natural disaster.

Eligible damaged property must be a primary place of residence.

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
